Community Service

The Court has ordered you to complete Community Service.

It is a process by which juveniles are required to make amends to the community, and be held accountable for the offense which they have committed. Juveniles who are ordered by the Court to participate in this program are given a list of suggested sites where they can perform their community service.

• What is It?

- Juveniles ordered to perform community service are not confined to render their service within the bounds of Lake County, but may also complete their service at any nonprofit organization. Community Service is an alternative to incarceration for juveniles who have committed less serious offenses.

Conditions

- The juveniles are required to work without pay for a prescribed number of hours within a designated time frame.
- They must report on time for their community service and are expected to put in an honest day's work.

Questions

- All questions or exceptions to Community Service must be cleared through the Probation Officer or Intake Officer. Intake and Probation Officers are available from 8:00AM – 4:30PM, Monday – Friday.

Parental Obligations

- It is the responsibility of the juveniles, with the help of parents, to initiate contact with a particular site and arrange the logistics such as time, day, and transportation to and from the site.
